Aviation: air traffic controller, airline management, flying instructor, pilot.

Business: accountant, business management/ownership, human resources, information systems, marketing, non-profit organization executive director, public relations.

Construction: carpentry, construction worker, contractor, draftsman, equipment operator.

Education: college professor, counselor, dean, school administrator, teacher.

Emergency Services: EMT, firefighter, paramedic.

Engineering: Civil, electrical, marine, mechanical, structural engineer.

Finance: banker, insurance broker, mortgage banker, stockbroker, financial planner.

Government: councilmember, executive branch official, government services, judiciary, legislator, state/county department administrator.

Hospitality Industry: chef, hospitality services, hotel management, restaurant management.

Law/Law Enforcement: attorney, coroner, court administrator, customs inspector, FBI, judge, park ranger, police officer/administrator, sheriff.

Media: newspaper/magazine editor, news anchor, photojournalist, reporter, TV producer.

- WHO:** Registration for this program is limited to 125 high school girls who are interested in exploring non-traditional careers.
- WHAT:** **Teaming for Tomorrow** is a career exploration conference which gives high school girls throughout the state an opportunity to spend time with successful career women. The three key components are:
1. An all-day workshop that will help girls learn effective communication skills, resume writing skills and interview techniques, and personal goals assessment.
 2. A banquet where the girls have an opportunity to meet other girls and career women in a social setting.
 3. A day "on the job" with a women mentors in the careers in that the girls are interested.
- WHEN:** Monday and Tuesday, February 17th & 18th. The conference begins at 8:00 am on Monday and ends at 4:00 PM on Tuesday.
- WHERE:** Hilton Hawaiian Village, Coral Ballroom
- HOW:** Apply now through the Girl Scout Council of Hawaii office. Fill out the student application and submit the registration fee of \$85, or a non-refundable deposit of \$5. For scholarship assistance and/or assistance for travel from the neighbor islands, complete the scholarship portion of the application. Application deadline is November 1, 2002 and applicants will be notified of acceptance by December 1, 2002.
